Contributing Insights from Text Linguistics to the Pragma-dialectical Approach to Argumentation and the Argumentative Model of Emotions

Domains: Argumentation Theory, Rhetoric, Communication

Theoretical framework:

- the pragma-dialectical approach to argumentation
- the argumentative model of emotions

developed in Western Europe during the last three decades.

Outcomes:

The two approaches to discourse study and analysis provide rich insights into how the speaker responds to the expectations of a particular audience in agency of her words and discourse structure, while sometimes *neglecting critical and judgmental attitudes of the remaining receivers of the encoded message*. In this respect, analysis of **dissociation**, as a *rhetorical strategy and argumentative technique*, and of **metadiscourse**, or *discourse about discourse*, has shown that arguers appear to be *more committed to rhetorical sucess than to pursuing dialectical objectives in advancing a standpoint and providing justification for it.*

The new line of inquiry concerns the implicit contribution of Text Linguistics to the envisaged fields, which is not clearly and sufficiently highlighted. An integrative framework is needed, which could relate research in the concerned theories, methodologies, approaches, and models of the discourse phenomenon.
